<p><b><u>D&amp;T – learn food tech skills</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*Create a healthy lunch for your family-ask for adult supervision!</li> <li>*Using a knife, slice some vegetables</li> <li>*Using a peeler, peel a carrot</li> <li>*Using a grater, grate some cheese / carrot</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Phonics / Spelling</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*Most words with two syllables that end in the l sound, like kettle and bubble, are spelt with <b>-le</b>. Can you hear a weak little uh sound before the l sound in these words? Purple, kettle, middle, table</li> <li>*We can hear it but we can't see it in these words. Don't write it!</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Art</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*Create a healthy plate of food- Use or make a paper plate, using collage or drawing add your favourite healthy food. Perhaps you could use playdough to sculpt your food items.</li> </ul>	<p><b><u>Reading</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*There are 5 short Reading Comprehension tasks.
