

Year 5 Rainforest Project

Over the final two weeks of the term, we would like you to create your own 3D rainforest model!



The pictures above are simply ideas - you can be as creative as you like - though there are a few things that we would definitely like you to include:

- It must be 3D.
- The 4 different layers need to be clearly shown and easy to identify.
- Each of the 4 layers must include at least one 3D animal, which you need to make (so, no lego, playmobil, plastic animals). Maybe you could make them from papier mache or salt dough?

Alongside your model, we would like you to produce a written explanation of your rainforest. This is your chance to bring together all the knowledge you have gained over the last few weeks (imagine your explanation is for someone who doesn't yet know anything about a rainforest).

You can present your writing in any way you like. Some ideas could be:

- A booklet
- A poster
- Separate sections of writing to explain each section
- Maybe even a poem!

The choice is yours!

This project needs to reflect 8 days of learning so we suggest you spend the first day gathering ideas, considering the resources that are available to you and planning what you are going to do and how long each part will take. If you then discover your idea is only going to take 3 days, you can rethink before you begin. This really is an opportunity to create something impressive!! You will need to be organised, work independently, solve problems and be creative. We hope you will enjoy yourself and are proud of the outcome.
